The John Young History Maker Award was named after our hometown hero, Captain John Young, who was the ninth person to walk on the moon as Commander of the Apollo 16 mission in 1972.

Dr. McGee has received numerous accolades during her 46-year career as an educator, administrator, and civic champion, including being lauded as "Woman of the Decade" by Orlando Business Journal. As its president for 22 years, Dr. McGee has led Seminole State College in its growth from a single-campus community college into a dynamic state educational institution with four campuses and almost 30,000 students annually. In July 2018, Dr. McGee will step down from the presidency and will transition into the role of President Emerita to provide fundraising assistance to the college and develop an Emeritus College for eligible retired faculty and administrators.

Albert Nelson

Orlando native Albert Nelson graduated from Jones High School in 1955, then attended Johnson C. Smith College. After graduation, Mr. Nelson worked for the state of North Carolina. He also served in the Army as a paratrooper in the 11th Airborne Division. In 1972 Orlando Mayor Carl Langford hired him to be the city's Director of Human Relations, making Mr. Nelson the first African American director to work for the City of Orlando. He was mostly responsible for the integration of the Orlando Police and Fire Departments. Mr. Nelson also served as the President of the International Association of Human Rights Agencies from 1981 to 1983.
